


As well, Zoe read that God's Angels are used to serve as God's messengers to bless His creation.


Several years later, when Mrs. Zoe became a grade two teacher, she had a student named Dino in her class.

Mrs. Zoe noticed Dino's pain.



A little while later, J.P. finally had the courage to whisper into Connor's ear: "It hurts my heart when you laugh as I fall and when you call me names."


Connor was a good little puppy with a huge heart. He not only apologized but also promised to not do that again. "Will you forgive me, J.P.?" he asked quietly.

She kept thinking about how she was made fun of because of her unusual height and clumsy walking. Plus, her child made another poor choice and would not listen to her.


Mrs. Zoe felt that her prayers were not heard.

Needless to say, Mrs. Zoe came to school feeling like her love tank was completely drained.




Somehow, Mrs. Zoe managed to pull herself to the staff bathroom. She sat crying and crying on the toilet.

With her eyes swimming in tears, Mrs. Zoe realized in shock that the time on her watch said 8:45!


"I need to go to the classroom. The children are coming in soon," she whispered to herself.


Right after that, the first student entered the classroom. Connor bounced straight in and came to her desk with a big smile.


Carefully stepping forward so as not to trip, J.P. exclaimed: "Open your eyes!"

Her heart was starting to feel a bit lighter.






It was almost 9:00 a.m. Mrs. Zoe watched her students flock in. Almost everyone was present, except for Dino.

"Thank you, Dino!"


At that very moment, a warm blanket-type feeling of LOVE came over Mrs. Zoe.

How do you think Mrs. Zoe felt now?



"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me, Philippians 4 verse 13.






