#### DEVOTIONAL AND ENCOURAGEMENT

2 Chronicles 7:14 - "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."

Joel 2:28-29 - "And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days."

Acts 2:17-18 - "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy."

#### **DEVOTIONAL AND ENCOURAGEMENT**

Revival is a powerful movement of the Holy Spirit that brings about a renewed passion for God and His kingdom. The Bible speaks of revival in both the Old and New Testaments, and it's clear that God desires for His people to experience revival in their hearts and in their communities.

2 Chronicles 7:14 teaches us that revival begins with humility, prayer, seeking God's face, and turning from wickedness. When we come before God with a humble and contrite heart, He promises to hear our cries, forgive our sins, and heal our land.

Joel 2:28-29 and Acts 2:17-18 both speak of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the last days. God promises to pour out His Spirit on all people, regardless of age, gender, or social status. This means that everyone has the opportunity to experience revival, to prophesy, and to be used by God to bring about His purposes.

#### **PRAYER**

In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.



# Prayer for the Second Coming of Christ

Matthew 24:42-44 - "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come. But understand this: If the owner of the house had known at what time of night the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and would not have let his house be broken into. So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him."

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 - "For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever."

Revelation 22:20 - "He who testifies to these things says, 'Yes, I am coming soon.' Amen. Come, Lord Jesus."

#### **DEVOTIONAL AND ENCOURAGEMENT**

The second coming of Christ is a foundational belief of the Christian faith. Jesus Himself told us to keep watch, because we do not know the day or the hour of His return. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 describes the re- turn of Christ as a glorious event, where the dead in Christ will rise first and those who are still alive will be caught up to meet Him in the air.

As we wait for the second coming of Christ, we are called to live in readiness and expectancy, constantly looking to Him and seeking to do His will. Revelation 22:20 encourages us to long for His return and to pray for His coming soon.

#### **PRAYER**

Dear Lord Jesus, I believe that You are coming again, just as You promised. I long for Your return and pray that it would be soon. As I wait for Your coming, help me to be watchful and ready, living each day in a way that honors You. Help me to be faithful to Your calling, seeking to do Your will and to serve You with all my heart. I pray that You would come soon and bring about the fullness of Your kingdom. In Your precious name, I pray. Amen.



## **Prayer for Strength in Trials**

Psalm 46:1-3 - "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging."

Isaiah 40:29-31 - "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

James 1:2-4 - "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything."

#### DEVOTIONAL AND ENCOURAGEMENT
