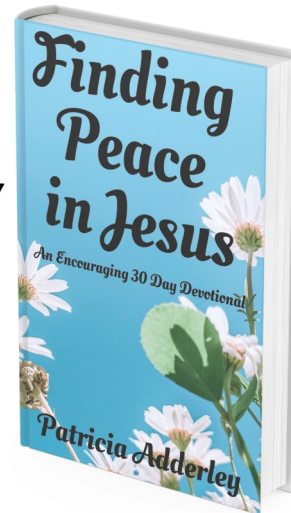



## A Note From the Author

*This guided prayer journal was written in order to help you discover your own true identity in Christ.*

*Even though I accepted Jesus as my Savior at an early age, I spent a long time dealing with depression, and self-confidence issues. I took my confidence from how I looked, how I performed at work or at home, the type of job I had or how much money was in the bank.*

*I never really understood the power of God's Word and what it said about my true identity as well as how that understanding affected my life. I had a lifetime of false belief systems. I had based my identity on all of these external things instead of simply on who God created me to be.*

*I have come to understand that my purpose stems from knowing Who I am in Christ. It does not come from what I do, what denomination I belong to, how I dress or how much money is in the bank. It comes solely from what God has already done for me and who He created me to be.*

*At the beginning of this journal there is room for you to write down the lies that you have believed about who you are, answered prayers, and God's truth about your true identity.*

*Every 13 weeks the focus changes to a different theme. There is room to reflect on what that week's scripture verse is saying, what you learned, what you are thankful for, prayer requests and notes.*

*I hope this guided prayer journal will help you understand who God created you to be as well.*
